<p>"Limousine" means an unmarked luxury passenger automobile or SUV and has a seating capacity of not more than 15 persons, including the driver.</p> <p>License plates. A person who operates a limousine for other than personal use must apply to register the vehicle with limousine plates.</p> <p>Limousine license plates are issued upon the applicant's compliance with laws relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles and drivers. The application must include a certificate of insurance verifying that a valid insurance policy is in effect and giving the name of the insurance company, the number of the insurance policy, and detailing the proper aggregate amount of coverage is in place.</p> <p>The applicant must provide proof that the passenger automobile license tax and Limousine plate fee have been paid for each limousine receiving license plates.</p> <p>Limousine license plates may not be transferred to the new owner upon sale of the limousine, but may be transferred to another limousine owned by the original applicant upon notifying the registrar and paying a \$5 transfer fee. Special Plate application form PS2010 may be used to transfer Limo plates.</p>	DEPUTY PAID STAMP
